The Greater Ukiah Chamber of Commerce & Education Scholarship Criteria

Purpose: The Ukiah Foundation for Commerce and Education awards scholarships to Ukiah Valley area high school seniors based on demonstrated entrepreneurial spirit and interest in pursuing a career owning or working within a local business.

Criteria: Students must be graduating high school seniors who reside within the Ukiah Valley area and intend to continue their education at a community or four-year college/university, tech or trade school. Considerations will be given to passion for chosen career path, experience and planning for career path and dedication to community. Students must submit a scholarship application on the form provided by the Greater Ukiah Chamber of Commerce/Ukiah Foundation for Commerce and Education as well as provide a Personal Statement and other required documentation as detailed on the scholarship application.

Guidelines: Scholarships will be awarded on an annual basis and disbursed directly to the educational institution of beneficiary. Students must maintain no lower than a 3.0 grade-point average (or equivalent) at initial application date.

Amount: Each scholarship awarded will be a minimum of \$1,000 with the ability to apply for subsequent years.

Deadline: The application deadline is April 26, 2019. The Greater Ukiah Chamber of Commerce/Ukiah Foundation for Commerce and Education uses the postmarked date to determine mailed entries.

Receiving Process: Recipient must show proof of registration for classes prior to scholarship funds being released to the educational institution.

To re-apply for subsequent years a copy of transcripts and an updated Personal Statement are required.
